"CATECHISM OF THE COUNCIL OF TRENT"

1. Every Sunday one of the Masses is said according to the Welfare and the Intention of the Faithful People who attend mass regularly at any of our three Chapels.
2. A recent Roman Instruction has clearly indicated that any faithful member of the Catholic Church can fulfill his or her Sunday obligation by attending any of the Rites of the Catholic Church. Therefore, any person attending the Latin (TRIDENTINE) Mass, most definitely and absolutely fulfills the Sunday obligation.
3. The Traditional Latin Mass is called "The Tridentine Mass" and the name comes from the name of the Council of Trent. "The Tridentine Mass" is not the official name for this rite of the Mass. Therefore, to differentiate this rite from the other rites of the Mass, such as the Byzantine, Ambrosian, etc., it has been called the Roman Rite, and the Missal is called the Roman Missal.
4. Confessions are heard before each Mass.
5. All should kneel for the reception of HOLY COMMUNION. The Communion rail is presently being constructed for St. Francis Chapel.
6. RELIEF TO ALL: the kneelers in St. Francis Chapel shall be padded.
7. A second prayer (ORATION) is said at every Mass. This oration is called "A domo" and is the official prayer against storms.
