From the dawn of civilization, Man has worshiped God through sacrifice. By the offering of precious gifts, men have publicly expressed adoration and love of God, their Creator. The greatest gift ever given to God by the Human Race was the life of His own Divine Son.

Our Blessed Lord, the night before He died gave something that no human being on dying was ever able to give, namely: Himself. On the solemn night of the Last Supper, He told His Apostles: "Do this in Commemoration of Me." The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass - and the Mass is essentially a Sacrifice - is offered in obedience to that injunction by which we look back to Calvary as He looked forward to Calvary. Between God and Man there stands one great barrier - sin. For by sin Man contracted in the worst bargain he ever made: a greater debt than he could ever pay. Only by the Son of God bringing His infinite justice to our bankruptcy, could that debt ever be acquitted.
