By the word RESURRECTION, however, we are not merely to understand that Christ WAS RAISED from the dead, which happened to many others, but that He rose BY HIS OWN POWER AND VIRTUE, a singular prerogative peculiar to Him alone. This was reserved for the Almighty power of God, as we learn from these words of the Apostle: "Although He was crucified through weakness, yet He liveth by the power of God."
