 First Sunday after the Epiphany

From the earliest times of Christianity there appears a permanent and unrelinquishable nucleus of teaching, hence of formation in the Faith. The Roman Catechism of the Council of Trent employed the same nucleus. All that is said about Faith - - after all - - is organized around FOUR fundamental elements: the Creed, the Our Father, the Ten Commandments and the Seven Sacraments. These embrace the very foundation of Catholic-Christian life. Today this fundamental structure is neglected in extensive areas of present-day Catholic teaching. The result has been a disintegration of the SENSE OF FAITH in the new generations, who are often incapable of comprehending their religion. Even the older generation has, to a great degree, lost sight of the fundamental structure of Catholicism, and has therefore become a product of a secular humanist infiltrated educational and social system. As a consequence most Catholic people no longer recognize an UNBIBLICAL WAY OF LIFE when they see it in operation.

1. Tuesday, January 6, 1987 was the Solemn Feast of the Epiphany of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. In some countries the Epiphany is called "Little Christmas". January 6th. is also the Twelfth Day of Christmas.
