" Let us avoid everything in acts or words, that could contribute to weaken Pontifical authority still more. If such or such an act of the Holy See does not or doesn't seem to conform to the truth or the law of the Church, let us say so frankly in such terms and with such prudence as are appropriate. An institution such as the Papacy has nothing to fear from a manifestation of the truth. But let us not act in a spirit of implicit or explicit contempt for these acts and for their author. This would only aggravate both the confusion of the faithful and the divisions in the Church, in addition to shaking apostolic authority, not to speak of the harm one would do oneself. For whosoever strikes against this Rock breaks himself in doing so."
