1. GOOD FRIDAY - THREE HOURS - 12:00 M. to 3:00 P.M. at St. Francis, Cullman
 Adoration of the True Cross and the Crown of Thorns.
2. Stations of the Cross - Good Friday - 7:00 P.M. St. Francis.
3. Easter Sunday - - MASS SCHEDULE: (NO 6:00 A.M. MASS)
 (1) St. Francis, Cullman 9:00 A.M. (NO 6:00 A.M. Mass)
 (2) St. Pius, Birmingham 12:00 M.
 (3) Our Lady of Lourdes, Montgomery 3:00 P.M.
4. Thursday is HOLY THURSDAY - Solemn Commemoration of the Most Blessed Eucharist. The day of the Miracle of the TRANSUBSTANTIATION - when the SUBSTANCE of the bread and the SUBSTANCE of the wine were CHANGED to the SUBSTANCE OF THE BODY AND THE SUBSTANCE OF THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST. The Blessed Eucharist is NOT a symbol - but the ACTUAL FLESH AND BLOOD OF OUR LORD. This is the belief of a true Catholic. The Blessed Eucharist is that which separates us from all those who are not of the same identity as we. One cannot call himself Catholic if he does not believe in the LITERAL meaning of the Holy Eucharist.
5. Friday is GOOD FRIDAY - a day of solemn penance and fasting and prayer. A DAY OF LAW - - FASTING AND ABSTINENCE - UNDER PAIN OF MORTAL SIN.
6. Saturday is HOLY SATURDAY.
