Improper presentation of the Catechism to the children of the early Twentieth Century is one important explanation of why so many Catholics of recent generations, without knowing it, have been candidates for what can be described as the easy-riding, man-centered, semi-secularized, modern Church of today. There has been no malice on the part of these good people. They have gone, as they had always been taught to go, where their priests and bishops directed them. The U-turn inflicted on them in the wake of the Second Vatican Council seemed extraordinary to most of them, but having been told, quite wrongly, that this was what the Church and the Council wanted, they did what they had been programmed to believe the Church wanted them to do. They submitted to the "renewal" imposed on them by the "EXPERTS" in what was called "THE SPIRIT OF VATICAN II". But this was a confidence trick of outsize proportions. The formalized religious outlook of the average "good Catholic"; the inclination over the years to trust and obey both priests and bishops; lack of significant depth in the knowledge of the Faith, placed most sincere Catholics in a great position to be conned. The remarkable thing is that having been taken for a ride in this fashion, so many of the Faithful People have survived this appalling trip and have held on to their faith!!
