If many Catholics no longer make use of the Sacrament of Penance, it is because they have a diminished sense of the need for redemption, and this comes from a set of beliefs that are now being widely taught by priests and accepted by Catholics. Three such teachings come to mind easily:

1. Every, or <u>almost everyone will go to Heaven</u>, so that there is no danger of anyone losing his or her soul - either because of God's infinite mercy, or because few sins are mortal sins, and it is almost impossible to commit a mortal sin subjectively.

2. The consequence is that there is no URGENT need on the part of the individual for reconciliation, or for the Church, or for Christ to ask for or expect reconciliation.

3. The reality of hell is questioned - or at least serious question is raised as to whether anyone ACTUALLY GOES THERE!!!

It seems that our whole pastoral effort, especially in regard to the Sacrament of Penance, has been profoundly affected by a commonly accepted notion that there is no urgency in BRINGING salvation to the people, because IT REACHES THEM ANYWAY-(which, if true, would make NOT ONLY CHRISTIANITY BUT ANY FORM OF RELIGION SUPERFLUOUS, except as a source of spiritual enjoyment and pleasure.
