He who knows the true meaning of dogma can never object to it. Dogma does not bind the mind - it frees it. It promotes the activity of the mind. It does not curtail the sphere of human reason. It simply describes the boundaries that separate truth from error. A church without dogma has no reason for its existence.

Christ said to the first ministers of His Church: "He that heareth you heareth Me.; and he that despiseth you despiseth Me." The authority of the Church does not enslave the human mind. It opens to the mind the realms of divine truth. Dogma does not hinder progress in science, nor does it place restrictions to the works of mathematics. Mathematics bids me believe that two and two make four. I am not free to believe that two and two make five. What would happen to the science of mathematics if everyone were free to apply his own whims to the solution of its problems? It would certainly become an absurdity. Much more truly can this be said of religion!
