The aspect of prayer of petition is emphasized by God's eagerness to answer it. We learn from the Fourth Book of Kings that the austere Isaias has scarcely passed out of the palace into the courtyard, when God sent him back to the weeping king with the favor he had sought - - his life. The faith of the centurion calls forth at once the creative words of Jesus ("your servant lives") and his servant does, indeed, live. These answers to prayer are concerned mainly with temporal benefits. But if God is so eager to answer such prayers, how much more readily will He listen to petitions for spiritual favors!
