God to Whom it is offered. Sadly, but in the new order of the Mass, attent-
ion is focussed upon the congregation rather than God. The main thrust of
the "reform" may be summed up in two words: INTELLIGIBILITY and PARTICIPATION
However, when once applied these principles set in motion a process which
cannot be stopped. The motion cannot be stopped because if the new Mass
must be adapted to suit the congregation it MUST evolve CONTINUALLY to keep
pace with the continually evolving cultural and social developments.
