The aim of the Traditional Liturgy was that the offering of sacrifice to a transcendent God should be conducted with fitting solemnity and dignity. The solemnity and dignity was the aim to be considered before all else. What matters in the Tridentine Mass is the reverence due to God--that the sacrifice should be celebrated in a manner appropriate to the Majesty of God to Whom it is offered. Sadly, but in the new order of the Mass, attention is focussed upon the congregation rather than God. The main thrust of the "reform" may be summed up in two words: INTELLIGIBILITY and PARTICIPATION. However, when once applied these principles set in motion a process which cannot be stopped. The motion cannot be stopped because if the new Mass must be adapted to suit the congregation it MUST evolve CONTINUALLY to keep pace with the continually evolving cultural and social developments.
