Richly endowed by nature and by Grace with every quality that could assure success in His dealings with men and with human affairs, the Life of JESUS CHRIST, nevertheless, as men judge things, was a complete failure!! Our Lord had constantly to drink to the dregs the cup of bitter and abject failure: those He healed were ungrateful; those He taught remained ignorant; and the hearts which He laboured to soften and convert remained hard and obdurate. Neither His eloquence nor His kindness won for Him the loyalty of His people. The few whom He did win to His side abandoned Him in the crisis of His Life! Most of us miss the real suffering and affliction of Our Lord's life when we read the Gospel, because we INSIST on maintaining the vague half-formed idea that IN ALL He went through, He was bouyed up and helped by the Divine Nature that was in Him. But this was not the case. This we MUST remember and we must remember it well if we are ever to have a good understanding of what Jesus was all about.!!!
