"The reasons why the Saviour suffered are to be explained to the people, that thus the greatness and intensity of the divine love towards us may the more fully appear. Should anyone inquire why the Son of God underwent His most bitter Passion, he will find that besides the guilt inherited from our first parents the principal causes were the vices and crimes which have been perpetrated from the beginning of the world to the present day and those which will be committed to the end of time. In His Passion and death the Son of God, our Saviour, intended to atone for and blot out the sins of all ages, to offer for them to His Father a full and abundant satisfaction."

3. HOLY THURSDAY - NO SOLEMN CEREMONIES - HOWEVER, ALL NIGHT ADORATION OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT - St. Francis. Church doors will be open from 6:00 P.M. Holy Thursday evening to 6:00 A.M. Good Friday morning. Everyone is urged to do whatever is possible in this regard.
4. GOOD FRIDAY - THREE HOURS - - St. Francis 12:00 M. to 3:00 P.M. Everyone is urged to do whatever is possible in this regard. The Three Hours are a great opportunity to do penance. For most people the Three Hours are not possible to observe because of work. At least some effort should be made by every individual to offer some act of mortification and reflection during that period of time. A short prayer would be very pleasing to our Suffering Saviour.
