BLESSING OF PALMS

The Lord teaches that only those who become children again can enter the kingdom of Heaven; that is: the vices of our souls and bodies must be renounced by our practice of CHILDLIKE simplicity. For children follow after their father, they love their mother, and they have no will to do evil to their neighbor; nor have they solicitude for the high opinion of others; they are not haughty; they neither hate others, nor tell lies; they believe what is told them, and what they hear they consider true. It behooves us, then, to return to the simpleness of little children, for when we are well rooted therein, we shall so far bear in ourselves an image of the sublime simpleness of the Lord Jesus. 'Woe to the world because of offences!' The lowliness of the Psssion is an offence unto the world. Such is the state of stupidity to which men's ignorance hath reduced itself, that it turneth away from the Lord God, because of the unsightliness of the Cross!'
