"AND WHEN THE DAYS OF THE PENTECOST WERE ACCOMPLISHED, THEY WERE ALL TOGETHER IN ONE PLACE: AND SUDDENLY THERE CAME A SOUND FROM HEAVEN, AS OF A MIGHTY WIND COMING, AND IT FILLED THE WHOLE HOUSE WHERE THEY WERE SITTING. The Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit), the Third Person of the Trinity, proceeds from the Father and the Son. The Latin word SPIRITUS means breath and the Holy Spirit is thus named because He is breathed forth, as it were, by the Father and the Son. He is the living bond of love springing from the Father and the Son. Since God is the source of all power, truth, and goodness, He must have a will as well as an intellect, love as well as thought. He must also love Himself, and this love is so powerful and so perfect that it is a living bond, A PERSON, who is love, co-eternal and co-equal with the Father and the Son:-
