The Church is not a party, nor an association, and neithe is it a club. Her permanent structure is NOT DEMOCRATIC, but Sacramental, consequently hierarchical. Authority in the Church is not based on the majority of votes; it is based on the authority of Christ Himself, which He willed to pass on to men who were to be His representatives until His promised return.
