The fact that some religious bodies profess a belief in One God and the immortality of the soul is well and good, but it is not enough to save them. The faith that justifies a man is the faith in God's Incarnate Son (JESUS CHRIST) and His redemption - - - NO OTHER! This is the minimal, explicit knowledge necessary in order to make an act of faith sanctifying. There is no other Divine Faith - there can only be one Divine Faith. Any religion which is not in agreement with the Deposit of Faith which comes to us from Divine Revelation or Sacred Tradition is simply not a part of the Mystical Body. God cannot be sanctifying souls all over the world by His Grace when they are rejecting that Grace by clinging to false religions and false teachings. The True Catholic Church does not have parts which intertwine with parts of other religious systems. What kind of Mystical Body would this be? Such a church would not be recognizable body at all, but a disorganized conglomerate, a multi-headed monster.
