Abbey in Collegeville, Minnesota — was appointed Apostolic Administrator. This appointment was the result of the Oklahoma Abbey's shortage of vocations; the lack of support given by their Mother House, and their refusal to adapt to the American mentality and way of life. It was because of their attitude that the Sacred Congregation of Religious suspended their right to elect an Abbot from among their own members. Consequently, on October 18, 1932, the Holy See appointed Father Mark Braun, O.S.B. of St. John's Abbey as Abbot of Sacred Heart Abbey, which by this time had changed its titular title to that of St. Gregory Abbey.
