The wind tore off some shingles and blew down several trees, while the very heavy rain leaked into places it was not supposed to. We rented a 50 foot hydraulic lift and repaired the roof damage, while at the same time going over all of the windows of our buildings, re-caulking them, and making repairs where needed.
