- From the very beginning we have had much trouble with our roofs, which are currently covered with asphalt shingles. We are on an elevated site, which affords a very beautiful view of the horizon and the magnificent sunsets and sunrises. But we pay the price of being high on a windy hill, and every time the winds blows, it plays havoc with the shingles. We are therefore being forced to have a metal roof installed on both the monastery and church. expensive, but there alternative, for after every storm the shingle roofs need repair.
- We recently had to replace the pump in our well, as it was too old and worn to pump as much water as was needed, and it was clogged with "iron bacteria" (a new discovery for us). A monthly dose of Clorox controls the bacteria. The well has been a real blessing.
