All the years of our lives in the past that were not dedicated to the love of God is time lost. All the years of our lives in the past given over to sin is time lost. However, let us here take note. It might well be that conversion has taken place in us, and that all has not been irretrievably lost. If the thought of having withheld pure love of God in days past spurs us on to courage and contrition; if lack of love in previous times brings us to a more serious and genuine intensification of our love for God HERE AND NOW, and if change takes place in us, with a firm resolve being held in place by a pure and humble spirit, then there will be angels and saints present to sing us to our rest and sanctification. What profound glory! It all rests here! □
