With untutored zeal and a constant flow of vitriol, mockery, and criticism they are in constant condemnation of justified Traditional Roman Catholic "resistance." As a consequence, many good-intentioned souls are led hither and you up the roads of further confusion, misunderstanding, disbelief, disedification, and disenchantment, finally turning away from religious observance altogether.

Many people also believe that the main difficulties that exist between Traditional Roman Catholics and Post Vatican II Catholics are caused by language – Latin versus the vernacular. The ritual ceremonial (vestments, music, chant, gestures of the celebrant, and all such like) is considered to be a serious difficulty. In either case nothing could be farther from the truth. To be sure, language and ceremonial are very important in orthodox, Traditional Catholic worship, but neither is centered at the very heart of the matter.

The matter of total concern is FAITH – the Faith difference between the Traditional Roman Catholic Church and the Post Vatican II Catholic Church. It is Faith that brings about Religious observance. The way we believe is the way we pray. Finally, the doctrine concerning the Blessed Eucharist is seriously different in the "new" Church from the official and correct teaching of Tradition.

When we reach that moment when life's term is over, and each of us lies on life's deathbed, what on earth could be more victorious – more triumphant – than to be able to cry out:

"I HAVE KEPT THE FAITH!"
