Our interior spiritual life, our interior spiritual recollection and contemplation must go beyond the moment of prayer. This does not mean that all remains the same all the day long. The cares of the day, the work, the tribulations, are all distractions which eat away at our recollection and contemplation. Nevertheless, the intention expressed during the moment of prayer must be a leaven so strong and powerful that it will give fermentation to all of the dough of the day's work, tribulations, and cares. The love that is given energy during the moment of prayer gives warmth to our thoughts when we are suffering from the stresses of the day. \square
