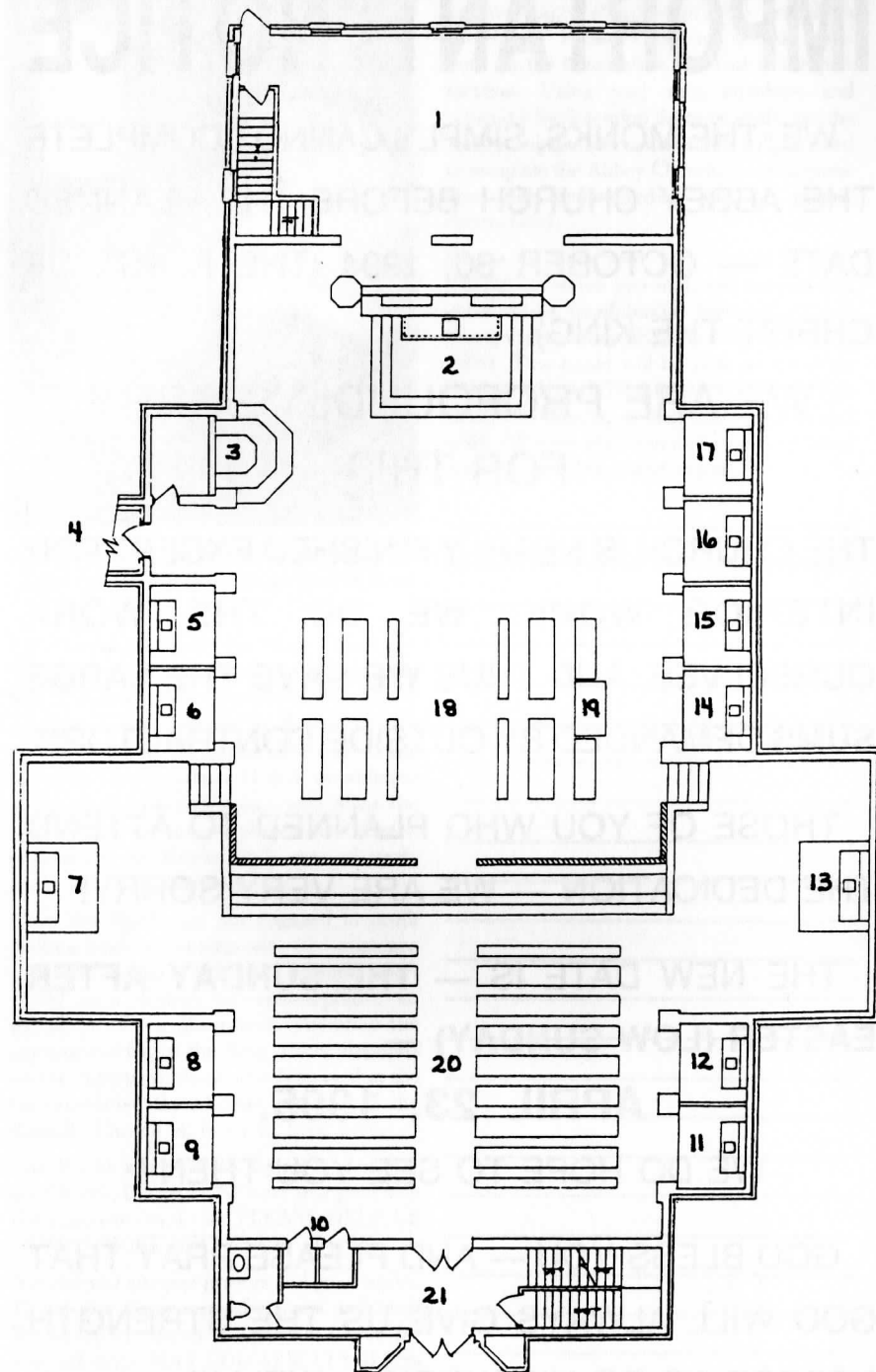


Many of our Friends and Benefactors have asked for a description of the Abbey Church. It is with profound humility and gratitude to the Good God that we tell you the following:
